RESOLUTION 2

A RESOLUTION OF STUDENT SUPPORT FOR THE INSTALLATION OF COMPLEMENTARY SUNSCREEN STATIONS IN THE NORTH SECTION AT DAVIS WADE STADIUM

WHEREAS, prolonged exposure to the sun can cause burns, and increase the risk of skin cancer, including melanoma, a leading cause of skin cancer-related deaths in the United States; and

WHEREAS, the University of Alabama, among other institutions, has successfully implemented complementary sunscreen stations at football games, promoting both sun safety and student well-being; and

WHEREAS, Mississippi State University currently does not provide complementary sunscreen stations at Davis Wade Stadium, placing students and attendees at greater risk of sun exposure without access to preventive resources; and

WHEREAS, the installation of complementary sunscreen stations would demonstrate Mississippi State University's commitment to student and guest health and safety, aligning with national trends in health-conscious campus facilities; and

WHEREAS, a proactive approach to sun protection at outdoor events would enhance the overall gameday experience and reduce health risks associated with UV exposure, fostering a safer environment for our Bulldog community; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that we, the Student Association Senate of Mississippi State University, support the decision to install complementary sunscreen stations at Davis Wade Stadium to promote health and safety among all attendees; and
