Section 18 Rules Pertaining to the SA Senate Appropriations Committee

A. The SA Senate Appropriations Committee, working with the SA Treasurer, must provide a detailed report each semester regarding appropriations to other campus organizations. This report must be accessible by the entire Student Association and must include:

1. A list of all campus organizations that requested funding that semester 2. The amount and stated purpose of all approved appropriations

- B. The SA Senate Appropriations Committee, working with the SA Treasurer, must keep a detailed record of all apparent violations of the rules for appropriations found in Article VI, Section 5-E of these SA Bylaws. The SA Senate Appropriations Committee Chair is responsible for notifying the SA Senate of any violation of the rules for appropriations exceeding a monetary value of two hundred and fifty (250) dollars. This notification must take place at the first meeting of the SA Senate after the Chair becomes aware of the violation.
- C. The SA Senate Appropriations Committee, working with the SA Treasurer, must keep a detailed record of all durable equipment purchased by campus organizations utilizing SA funds. Durable equipment includes but is not limited to: tables, tents, electronics, branded materials such as table cloths or runners, coolers, etc.

- E. The following rules should govern the appropriation of SA funds:
 - 5. At the discretion of the SA Treasurer and SA Senate Appropriations Committee, funding may be denied for durable equipment as defined in Article III Section 18-C of these SA Bylaws, if the requesting organization has received funding for similar durable equipment within the past six (6) semesters.
